


Obtaining your current licenses information can be done in two steps. Knowing when your licenses expire is critical to keeping your PaloAlto Firewall up to date and is good information to have for annual budget purposes.

## Step #1.

Login to your PaloAlto firewall and click the "Device" tab at the top.

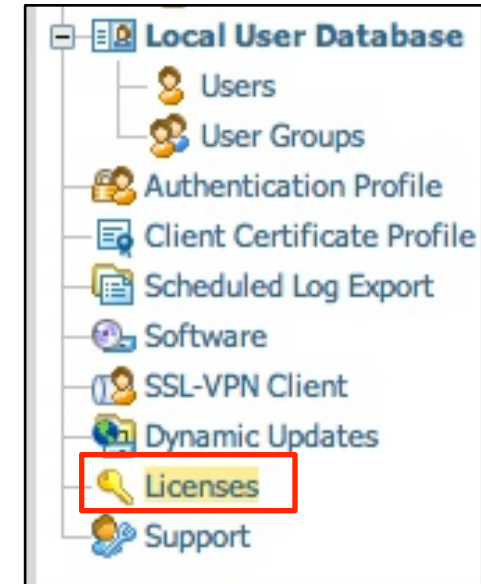

## Step #2.

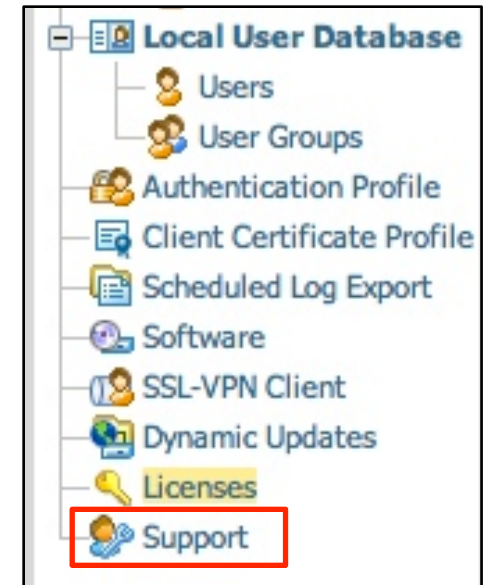
