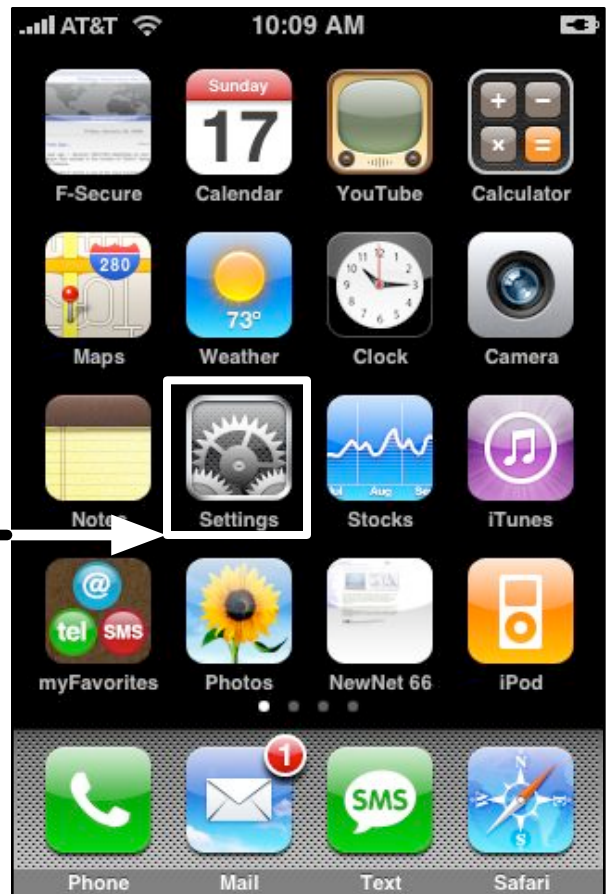




Setting up iPhone for The NewNet 66 Email System

This tutorial assumes you already have an email account setup.

From the main menu on your iPhone touch the "Settings" button.



Step #1 - Now touch Mail, Contacts, Calendars as seen below.



Step #2 - Touch your existing account.



Step #3 - Make sure your information looks similar to the configuration below.

Step #4 - Make sure your information looks similar to the configuration below.



← Enter your mail server name here.
Example: mail.claremore.k12.ok.us

← Use your full email address

← Re-enter your password if
necessary.

← Your mail server name should
already be here. If not, then enter
it just like you did in step #3.

← Touch here to enter the next step.

Step #5 - Make sure your information looks similar to the configuration below.



← Make sure Authentication is set to Password.
